On Friday, February 14, 2020, at 10:00 AM the County Board of Canvassers will hold a hearing to determine the validity of all provisional ballots cast in the special election. These hearings will be held at the Berkeley County Voter Registration and Elections Office, located at 6 Belt Drive Moncks Corner, SC 29461.
