On Friday May 8, 2020 South Carolina Governor Henry McMaster issued Executive Order 2020-33. Executive Order 2020-33 Rescheduled all Elections that were postponed by previous Executive Orders, 2020-09 and 2020-29. All Rescheduled Election will be held on Tuesday July 14, 2020

Please see the pertinent section below:

*NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of South Carolina and pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of this State and the powers conferred upon me therein, I hereby order that any election postponed pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order Nos. 2020-09 and 2020-29 shall be held on Tuesday, July 14, 2020, to include those elections identified in the tentative list provided by the SEC, which is attached hereto for ease of reference. Pursuant to section 7-13-1170 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, I designate and appoint the existing elections officials to perform the necessary official duties pertaining to the elections, in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory provisions, and to declare the results thereof. I expressly authorize the SEC to issue any necessary and appropriate additional or supplemental guidance regarding the interpretation, application, or implementation of this Order or to otherwise provide clarification regarding the same, through appropriate means, without the need for further Orders. This Order is effective immediately.*

RE: May 12, 2020 Town of Bonneau Election Postponed

On Monday April 27, 2020 South Carolina Governor Henry McMaster issued Executive Order 2020-29. Section 3 of the Executive Order postponed all Elections that were scheduled to take place on or before May 12, 2020. This Election will be rescheduled at a later date.

Please see Section 3 below:

***Section 3. Elections***

*To provide for and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of this State and to minimize and control the spread of COVID-19, pursuant to the cited authorities and other applicable law, I hereby determine, order, and direct as follows:*

*A. I hereby order and direct that any election, to include special, county, and municipal elections, scheduled to be held in this State or conducted by any agency, department, or political subdivision thereof, on or before May 12, 2020, shall be postponed and rescheduled. The State Election Commission ("SEC") shall work with county boards of voter registration and elections to ensure that individuals may register to vote without interruption. The SEC shall issue any necessary and appropriate additional or supplemental guidance regarding the implementation of this directive and the application of this Section.*

The Municipal Election Commission of the Town of Bonneau announces the general election for the Town of Bonneau to be held on Tuesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

The following offices shall be included in this election: Two (2) Council members from the Town of Bonneau for term expiring four years. The polling place for this district is Bonneau Town Hall, 420 Municipal Ln Bonneau, SC 29431.

Persons desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020. To register, one must contact the County Board of Voters Registration.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices may file at the Bonneau Town Hall. Books will be open for filing on February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at noon and remain open during regular Business hours until Thursday, February 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at noon.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

Polls shall open 7:00 AM on Election Day and close at 7:00 PM.

The Municipal Election Commission shall certify the election results on Thursday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
