Planning Commission makes recommendations for requests for rezoning, ordinance text amendments, and other legislative items. Following the Planning Commission Meeting, rezoning and other legislative items, unless defeated, deferred, postponed, or tabled, will be considered by County Council at both Land Use Committee and full County Council in up to three (3) readings. County Council possesses the final decision-making authority on requests for rezoning and other legislative items and, should an item be defeated by County Council, it will not progress to the next regularly scheduled County Council meeting unless a motion to reconsider or remand back to the Land Use Committee is made. If a rezoning or other legislative item is approved at Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Reading, the change goes into effect immediately. Please follow items of interest through Land Use Committee/County Council. Land Use Committee/County Council meetings are typically held at **6:00 PM** in the General Assembly Room unless advertised otherwise.
